Dear Parents, students, teachers, and employees of Providence Hall Charter School,

As a charter non-profit school, Providence Hall Charter School is required to be in compliance with the United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) and the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA). There is not an area in our building that has been identified as an air-quality threat to our students, faculty, and staff. To stay in compliance it is necessary to have a AHERA Management Plan.

The following is our management plan for the 2015-2016 school year.

- Our management plan consists of a six month periodic surveillance of the property by our Director of Operations and Maintenance Engineer to look for any possible issues relating to air quality.
- Our Maintenance engineer has received the proper professional training for these inspections. Any new maintenance engineer will receive the same training.
- We schedule a 3yr re-inspection in early spring to identify any new issues that may arise.
