Dear Parents,

Providence Hall will be conducting vision screening this month for the following grades: kindergarten, 1st, 3rd, 5th, 7th and 9th. State law require parents be informed that school vision screening is not a substitute for a complete eye exam and vision evaluation by an eye doctor. It is recommended that your child see an eye care specialist yearly. School screenings do not evaluate eye health or prescribe treatments. Because academic learning is 80% visual, healthy eyes and good vision are essential for success in school.

You will receive a referral letter if your child fails the screening.

Please provide the school with written notification if you **DO NOT** want your child to participate in the screening program.
