## Patriot Pride Award Requirements

### Kindergarten

The Patriot Pride award is designed to challenge students. These goals are centered on developing strong academic and citizenship skills within our students. Students will choose 4 goals that they would like to work on throughout the school year; 2 must be from the patriotic category and 2 from the other. These goals can be worked on in the home and at school but must be quality work or it will not be accepted. The teacher or the parent can initial each goal as it is passed off. At the end of the year if their 4 goals have been completed, the student will be recognized for their accomplishment in our end of year assembly. This sheet must be initialed and returned to your teacher by **Friday, May 14, 2021**.

#### **Patriotic Pride (Choose 2)**

1. Communicate your gratitude to a military member and share with the class.
2. Take action in your community to fulfill a need and display your action within our school.
3. Visit a patriotic site and share what you learned with your class.
4. Study a patriotic symbol and share with the class why it is important.

#### **Other Goals (Choose 2)**

1. Create an ABC book with each letter of the alphabet and the sound the letter makes (both long and short vowel). Include pictures for each of the sounds and label the pictures. Share with your class!
2. Create and implement a science experiment that encourages scientific investigation. Bring in pictures/videos to show the class what you learned.
3. Create a song or rhyme using 15 or more sight words and teach it to your class.
4. Interview 2 community helpers and find how they use math in their jobs. Draw or take a picture with them and write a sentence about what you learned and present it to the class.
