



Policy Development

- I. By expressing intent, policies specify the direction or delineate the scope of organizational action and/or limits on action.
- II. Therefore, adoption of new policies or amendment of existing policies is solely the responsibility of the Board of Trustees (Board).
- III. New or amended policies shall be adopted and implemented only by the vote of a majority of a quorum of the Board present when such action has been scheduled on the agenda of a Regular Meeting or Special Session.
- IV. With the exception of statutory requirements or instances where specific application of a policy is essential to the long term welfare of the school, policies should be flexible enough to allow for extenuating circumstances or circumstantial changes.
