



AHERA Asbestos Management Plan

I. ASBESTOS HAZARD EMERGENCY RESPONSE ACT

- A. As a charter non-profit school, Providence Hall Charter School (PHCS) is required to be in compliance with the United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) and the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA).
- B. No areas in any PHCS facility has been identified as an air-quality threat to our students or employees.
- C. To stay in compliance PHCS is required to have an AHERA Asbestos Management Plan.

II. PHCS AHERA ASBESTOS MANAGEMENT PLAN DETAILS

- A. PHCS' AHERA Asbestos Management Plan consists of a six month periodic surveillance of the property by the Director of Operations and Maintenance Engineer to look for any possible issues relating to air quality.
- B. PHCS' Maintenance Engineer has received the proper professional training for these inspections. Any new Maintenance Engineer will receive the same training.
- C. PHCS schedules a three (3) year re-inspection in early spring to identify any new issues that may arise.
