30 - Notification of Threat or Incident Policy

1. When Notification Occurs

- 1.1. In accordance with 53G-9-604 of Utah State code, Providence Hall Charter School (PHCS) will notify parents/guardians as follows:
 - 1.1.1. notify a parent/guardian if the parent's/guardian's student threatens to commit suicide
 - 1.1.2. notify the parents/guardians of each student involved in an incident of bullying, cyber-bullying, hazing, abusive conduct, or retaliation of the incident involving each parent's/guardian's student.

2. How Notification Occurs

- 2.1. Notifications to parents/guardians will be done via phone, email, mail, phone, or other method.
- 2.2. In the case of threat of suicide, a parent/guardian will be notified by phone or in person.

3. Notification Documentation

- 3.1. PHCS will maintain a record of the notification to parents/guardians in accordance with student privacy law and policy, student data protection policy, and the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act.
- 3.2. A record will be maintained in the student's cumulative file as well as entered into the school-wide student information system any time a student threatens suicide or is involved in the aforementioned incidences outlined in 53G-9-604 of Utah State code.

4. Providing Notification Information & Making Recommendations

At the request of a parent/guardian, PHCS may provide information and make recommendations related to an incident or threat as described in 53G-9-604 subsection (1).

5. Expunging Notification Record

- 5.1. PHCS shall provide a copy of a notification record in accordance with 53G-9-604 subsection (4) if a student makes a request and then PHCS will expunge said notification record in accordance with the same subsection if the student
 - 5.1.1. has graduated from high school AND
 - 5.1.2. requested the record be expunged.

6. Record Maintenance

- 6.1. PHCS will maintain a record using the *Record of Parent/Guardian Notification of Threat or Incident* form for all incidences outlined in Code 53G-9-604 above.
- 6.2. These records will be maintained in the student's cumulative file.

This form is a record required to be maintained securely and confidentially by the school consistent with Utah Code Ann. §53G-9-604(3) following parent notification of a student suicide threat, or an incident of bullying, cyber-bullying, hazing, abusive conduct, or retaliation.
