90 - AHERA Asbestos Management Plan

1. **Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act**
 - 1.1. As a charter non-profit school, Providence Hall Charter School (PHCS) is required to be in compliance with the United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) and the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA).
 - 1.2. No areas in any PHCS facility have been identified as an air-quality threat to our students or employees.
 - 1.3. To stay in compliance PHCS is required to have an AHERA Asbestos Management Plan.
2. **PHCS AHERA Asbestos Management Plan Details**
 - 2.1. PHCS' AHERA Asbestos Management Plan consists of a six (6) month periodic surveillance of the property by the Director of Operations and Maintenance Engineer to look for any possible issues relating to air quality.
 - 2.2. PHCS' Maintenance Engineer has received the proper professional training for these inspections. Any new Maintenance Engineer will receive the same training.
 - 2.3. PHCS schedules a three (3) year re-inspection in early spring to identify any new issues that may arise.
