1. Policy

Providence Hall Charter School recognizes funds as measurable and recorded in the accounting records if the revenues are collected within ninety (90) days of year end. A receivable may be recorded on the books if it is anticipated that the funds will be received within this timeline. In the event the funds are not received, an adjustment will be entered on the books before issuing the audited financial statements.
